Focus on writing: Strong, clear writing comes from coherent thinking and so in this class, we will practice strengthening both. Students will be asked to make sense of literature by making inferences based on text evidence. Students will also write about themselves in narrative essays. Finally, students will write informational essays based on sound research practices.
